

Laughlin, Nevada – Great Fun Indoors and Outdoors

First Day – Cruising on Water or Wheels

From whatever direction you arrive in Laughlin, you'll be greeted by the breathtaking view of the hotel casinos clustered along the banks of the majestic Colorado River. Check into one of the three- and four-star hotels, each with its own unique theme, and enjoy either a river or mountain view from your room. Stroll along the **River Walk** and board a paddlewheel boat for a leisurely 1 1/2-hour cruise. You can listen to a historical account of Laughlin and the



surrounding area while enjoying a cool beverage from the onboard snack bar. Upon your return, walk through the **Riverside's Car Collection**, where you'll see more than 70 antique, classic and celebrity vehicles, all for free admission. Water taxis conveniently transport you to the hotel dock of your choice. Enjoy live entertainment in the evening at any of the lounges or showrooms inside the Laughlin hotels.

Second Day – The Old West Then and Now

A short drive 28 miles southeast transports you back in time to the historic Western mining town of **Oatman, Arizona**. Visit the historic Oatman Hotel where Clark Gable and Carole Lombard spent their honeymoon in the 1960s. Take your picture with a resident feral burro or watch a re-enactment of an Old West shoot out between bank robbers and the local sheriff. Browse the handmade art, jewelry and quirky souvenir shops located along historic Route 66. Or take a guided horseback trail ride into the Black Mountains for spectacular views of the Colorado River Valley. Dust off your boots and return to the modern comfort of your Laughlin hotel. Test your luck on the latest slot and video machines or pull up a seat for a friendly low-stakes table game.



Third Day – Rails and Sales



Get ready for outdoor adventure and join **Laughlin Adventure Tours** for exploration of the surrounding desert. You can be the driver or ride along in a two- or four-seat, sand-rail vehicle for a fun guided tour. Traverse the rugged desert terrain through the Black Mountains, Thumb Butte or Secret Pass. Learn the history of the wild west and how the Colorado River drew settlers to the area.

Once back in Laughlin, you can explore the

sales going on at the **Laughlin Outlet Center**. Known for their incredible discounts, you're sure to find your own "jackpot" at this outlet mall that features 50 stores, a food court and nine-screen, stadium-style movie theater, all conveniently located on Casino Drive in the center of town.

Fourth Day – Golf or Gorge!

If you enjoy golf, you've come to the right destination. There are six 18-hole courses within 30 minutes of Laughlin hotel casinos. **Laughlin Ranch** is only eight minutes from the hotels and was rated one of the top 10 upscale, new golf courses by *Golf Digest* in 2005 and Best in the State for architecture in 2009 – 2010. **El Rio Country Club** and **Los Lagos** are championship public courses and only 25 minutes from the hotels. Both **Mojave Resort Golf Course** and **Desert Lakes** are area favorites and only 20 minutes from Casino Drive. Laughlin's weather makes golf a year-round sport.



Not a golfer? Then a jet boat ride to Lake Havasu and the famous London Bridge via the Colorado River may be more to your liking. **London Jet Boat Tours** departs Laughlin at 10 a.m., and the two-hour ride features spectacular views of Topock Gorge and the area's wildlife. The layover in Lake Havasu City provides plenty of time to sightsee and enjoy a light lunch. You return to Laughlin by 4 p.m., in time to enjoy dinner and exciting

nightlife.
